

Repair light scuffs in leather

Scuffs and scratches in leather furniture is a common problem, but a one that is quite easily repaired.

Take a look at this leather settee arm rest, on the left below you can see that the colour has been scuffed off the piping through general wear and tear.

After the sofa was thoroughly cleaned using TLC Leather Care's especially formulated leather cleaner. The damaged area was lightly wet sanded, using a very fine grit sand paper, to remove any rough areas, and then cleaned with an alcohol cleaner. The colour was then mixed up to an exact match, two coats were applied by hand and a third coat applied by spray gun to blend into the surrounding leather.

Once the colour had dried, we applied three coats of leather finish to match the original sheen of the furniture, to seal in the colour, and finally once everything was completely dry we applied a leather protector to condition and protect the new finished leather.
